### Notification

In view of closure of the Institute for students and scholars, due to COVID-19, the classes are being engaged online. The assessment of the Autumn 2020 semester will have to be made in the coming months of this Autumn 2020 semester.

Considering the difficulties and limitations experienced in the assessment procedure based on weighted ESE digital examinations and based on the feedback from faculty and the students, the assessment modalities for the ongoing academics in Autumn 2020 in continuous online mode has been approved in the 41<sup>st</sup> meeting of Senate of the Institute.

**1. For NIT Scheme of courses, the following are the assessment modalities for continuous evaluation in the current autumn semester:**

- a. If the students are not be allowed on campus to appear for the examination (physical mode) till the end of the semester due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the continuous evaluation of the theory subjects will be done based on the following 4 components:
  - i. The first component of continuous evaluation is in form of either a Term paper or Term project or Conference paper (in Indexed conferences) to be submitted individually by each student in consultation with the subject-teacher for each theory subject. A term paper shall be a report/solution to a study/literature survey/ practical/analytical problems/topics based on the syllabus covered/advanced topic of the related subject which shall have to be submitted by the end of the semester as decided by the concerned teacher.
  - ii. The second component of continuous evaluation will be MCQ Quizzes having time bound submission in Google classroom/ any other LMS. In case a student fails to submit it within the stipulated time, then his/her marks may be reduced accordingly.
  - iii. The third mode of assessment is End Semester Examination (Digital Mode) of 3 hours.
  - iv. The fourth mode of assessment is Viva-Voce/Assignment submission (within one working day) at the end of the semester of the theory subject.

The schedule and distribution of marks for continuous evaluation is as given below:

- b. In case, the situation improves and the students be allowed on campus before the end of semester, the End Semester Examination (physical mode) of the theory subjects will be conducted for 40 marks combining the Digital Examination (20 marks) and viva-voce (20 marks). The other components for continuous evaluation of Theory subjects [Term Paper / Term Project / Conference Paper (indexed) and MCQ Quizzes] and their distribution of marks will remain UNCHANGED.

c. The mode of Teachers' Assessment will remain the SAME as that of previous years.

### 2. For CBCS Scheme of courses, the following assessment modalities will be implemented for continuous evaluation of theory subjects in the current autumn semester:

a. If the students are not allowed on campus to appear for the examination (physical mode) till the end of the semester due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the continuous evaluation of the theory subjects will be done based on the following 4 components:

i. First component will be either Term Paper or Term Project which must be submitted individually by students as decided by the faculty of the subject concerned with prior approval of the respective HoD. A term paper shall be a report/ solution to practical/ analytical problems/topics based on the syllabus covered by the faculty member in the online classes which should be submitted in a fixed time-period.

ii. The second component will be MCQ Quizzes with time-bound submission in Google classroom/any other LMS. In case a student fails to submit it within the stipulated time, then his/her marks may be reduced accordingly.

iii. The third component of assessment will be End Semester Examination (Digital Mode) of 3 hours.

iv. The fourth mode of assessment is Viva-Voce/Assignment submission (within one working day) at the end of the semester of the theory subject.

The schedule and the distribution of marks for continuous evaluation is as below:

In case, the situation improves and the students be allowed on campus before the end of semester, the End Semester Examination (physical mode) of the theory subjects will be conducted for 40 marks combining the Digital Examination (20 marks) and viva-voce (20 marks). The other components for continuous evaluation of Theory subjects [Term Paper / Term Project / Conference Paper (indexed) and MCQ Quizzes] and their distribution of marks will remain UNCHANGED.

c. The mode of Teachers' Assessment will remain the SAME as that of previous years.

### 3. The modalities of the practical classes and assessment thereof will be declared later.

### 4. The academic calendar for the schedule of MCQ tests, submission of the Term Paper/Project and other academic activities will also be declared shortly.
