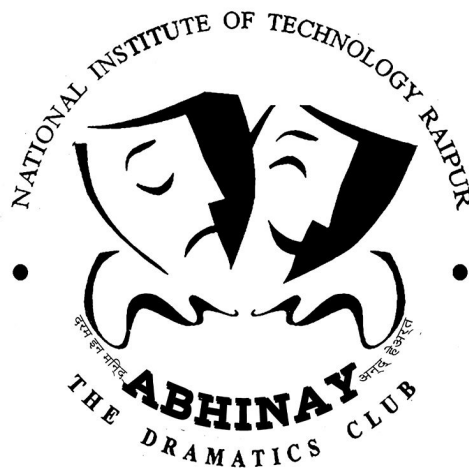

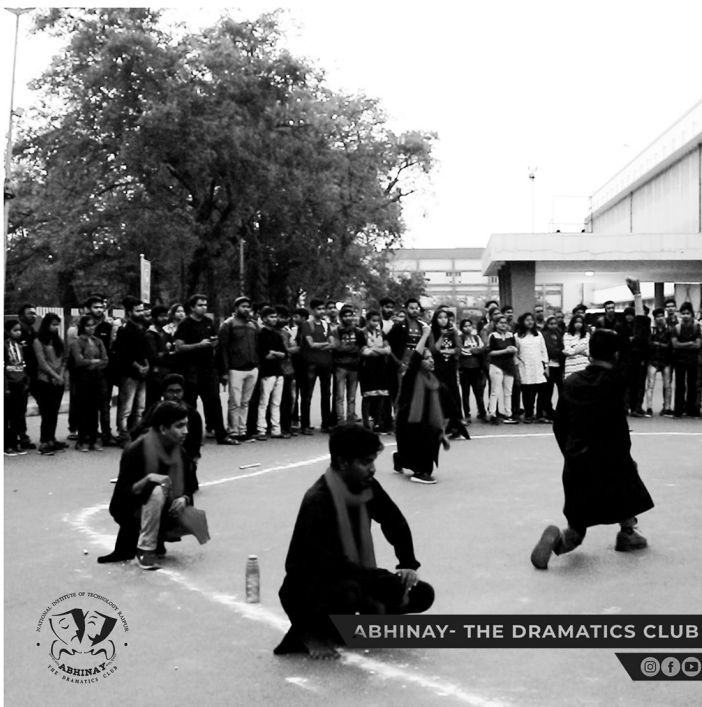

bringing change in their lives and in society.

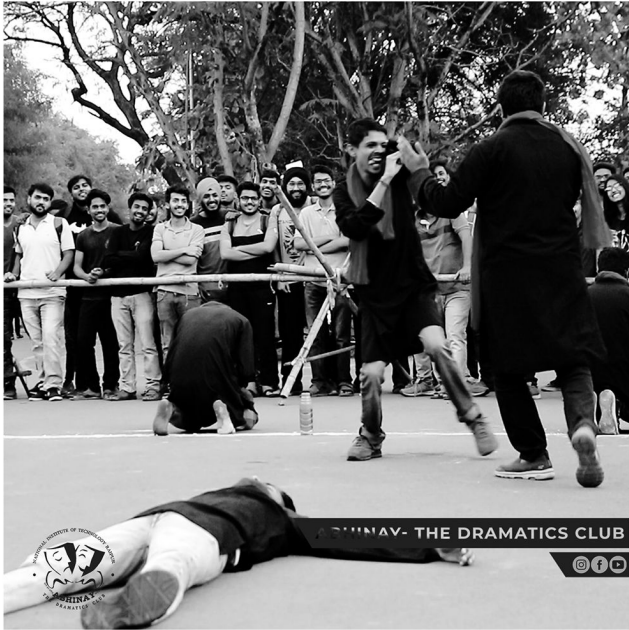
